COURSE DESCRIPTION

What better way to start learning a new language from scratch than jumping right in and getting good at the basics? This course employs a communicative approach involving all five language skills: listening comprehension, speaking, reading, writing, and culture.



Our course helps you to build your confidence in navigating through commonplace situations, such as shopping at the supermarket, asking for directions, ordering food and drink at restaurants, and making arrangements to meet people. You can also develop some useful everyday vocabulary! This course provides a general introduction to the German language, focusing occasionally on specific professional contexts of use related to the world of business or teaching.



Course Objectives: This course is designed to help participants of all teaching areas to acquire basic proficiency in communication within culturally significant contexts | Improve participants to develop their language skills, especially oral fluency, and enable them to incorporate German into daily life or even classroom situations | An integrated approach to teaching language skills with emphasis on vocabulary acquisition and basic grammatical structures | Promoting and expanding language abilities and skills are not only tasks of the area of study called language but also concern other areas of study. Language is, therefore, a tool to facilitate other areas of study | Promote a European dimension in education to raise awareness and understanding of other cultures and countries.

COURSE INFORMATION

Learning Outcomes

- Acquire basic cultural knowledge of German-speaking countries;
- Have a sense of German geography, society, sites of memory, historical figures, and culture-specific products such as fashion and cuisine;
- Develop the inter-human understanding between peoples across borders beyond one's own cultural area, and between peoples of other cultures within one's own borders due to globalisation, which is becoming increasingly important.
- Mastery of languages widens the horizons of experience and is important for one's own mobility and for professional qualifications. Contact with other languages helps towards developing the understanding of other cultures and towards reflecting on one's own language and culture;
- Share experiences and ideas with their peers.
